All solutions are welcome and will be considered equally, however we see a particular need for innovations to reduce at-berth emissions for our fleet.

**NEW for 2024 - TWO Neptune Awards for \$100,000 USD** will be given to the solutions that advance our understanding of the ocean and help minimize our impact on these resources, even while using them for human benefit, resulting in more resilient bodies of water including healthy marine life and coastlines. The Neptune Awards cover all maritime, blue economy, ocean environmental, and coastal resiliency topics as well as data gathering and analysis.

- Semifinalists will be selected the second week of September to participate in an additional round of review.
- 15 Finalists (announced the first week of October) will present at Ocean Exchange in Fort Lauderdale, FL, to delegates representing business, academia, government, and non-profits, who will select three monetary award winners and offer valuable networking opportunities.
